Flame Boss® 300 is intended for use only in dry, outdoor locations. Store the unit indoors in a dry location. If you know or suspect that the Flame Boss controller or power adapter has been exposed to excessive moisture or rain or was submerged in water, do not use the unit.

The 12 V DC power to the unit shall be supplied by a properly certified power adapter with SELV / LPS output.

Use only the power adapter provided with the unit.

Do not allow children to play with a Flame Boss 300. Keep away from children.

Flame Boss 300 is not to be used by persons with reduced physical, sensory, or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge.

Do not place or mount a Flame Boss 300 where it is exposed to excessive heat from the grill or smoker.

CONNECTING YOUR FLAME BOSS®



ADDING MULTIPLE PROBES (Y-CABLES)

Y-cables can be used to increase the number of meat probes from 1 to a max of 3. Y-cables work with High-Temperature Probes and Probes with Coated Cables.



2 Meat Probes: Plug 1 Y-cable into **pit jack** on controller. Plug pit probe into black lead labeled **PIT/M1**. Plug 1st meat probe into red lead labeled **M2/M3**. Plug 2nd meat probe into **meat jack**.

3 Meat Probes: Plug 1st Y-cable into **pit jack** on the controller. Plug pit probe into black lead labeled **PIT/M1**. Plug 1st meat probe into red lead labeled **M2/M3**. Plug 2nd Y-cable into **meat jack**. Plug 2nd meat probe into black lead labeled **PIT/M1** and 3rd meat probe into red lead labeled **M2/M3**.

USING FLAME BOSS®

Flame Boss WiFi enabled devices will automatically install any updated firmware when connected to the Internet. To find an updated manual that might include new features, go to www.FlameBoss.com/manuals.



The main screen shows the Set Temperature, Pit Temperature, Fan Speed, and Meat Temperature. With optional Y-cables and additional meat probes, you can monitor up to three different foods with your 300. Your Meat Temperatures will be shown in a rotating display and be identified by Mt1, Mt2, and Mt3 (switching every few seconds).

Pressing **MENU** several times will bring you back to this main screen. Flame Boss will also go back to the main screen after 15 seconds of inactivity. On each screen just press the \blacktriangle or \checkmark buttons to change the setting; press **MENU** to save your setting and go to the next screen.

Pit Temp Alarm On [+/- 20] Press **MENU** to cycle through each screen.

- \blacksquare or \blacktriangle changes the timer.
- ▼ or ▲ turns timer On or Off.
- \blacksquare or \blacktriangle selects the meat probe you want to configure.
- \blacksquare or \blacktriangle turns alarm mode to Off, On, or On & Keep Warm.

 \checkmark or \blacktriangle sets the desired Meat Temperature. Only shown when Meat Alarm is set to On or On & Keep Warm.

 \checkmark or \blacktriangle changes the Set Temperature to keep food warm after it reaches the Meat Done Temp. Only shown when Meat Alarm is set to On & Keep Warm.

 \blacksquare or \blacktriangle turns Pit Temp Alarm On or Off.

▼ or ▲ sets the Pit Temperature Alarm range. If the Pit Temperature goes outside this range from the Set Temperature, the Pit Temp Alarm will trigger.

▼ or ▲ cycles through [Skip] and [Enter]. Pressing MENU executes your choice.



Getting Started | Press **MENU** until the following is displayed.

WiFi Menu [Skip]	Press ▼ or ▲ to switch [Skip] to [Enter]. Press MENU until the following is displayed.	
WiFi Menu [On]	Confirm WiFi is set to [On]. If set to [Off] press \blacksquare or \blacktriangle to switch to [On]. Press MENU until the following is displayed.	
WiFi Mode [Station]	To switch to [Access Point] mode press ▼ or ▲ , then press MENU until WiFi status is displayed. Wait until the WiFi Status changes from <i>Resetting</i> to <i>AP Mode FB-#####</i> as displayed below:	
WiFi Status Resetting	→ WiFi Status Scanning → WiFi Status AP Mode FB-#####	

Note: [Access Point] on controller is for initial WiFi setup using our mobile apps or web browser only. Refer to the respective pages shown above for step-by-step instructions.

Flame Boss iOS or Android App

To install the Flame Boss app and add a controller,

open the camera app on your phone or tablet and scan the QR code.



If you are unable to scan the code above, open the browser (Chrome or Safari, for example) on your tablet or smartphone and enter the following address: https://myflameboss.com/app

Follow the instructions in the Flame Boss app to add a controller.

WiFi Setup / Web Browser

(Computer or Mobile Device)

- With your Flame Boss device set to Access Point Mode (directions on pg.15), go to the WiFi settings on your computer or phone and select FB-##### (controller's device ID) as the network.
- 2. Open your browser and go to http://192.168.4.1/
- 3. Scroll down, enter your SSID and Password on the form at the bottom and click Submit. Your browser should show this message: *Great!* You changed WiFi settings and your controller switched to station mode. Look for it on MyFlameBoss.com.

Your controller will switch to Station mode and use the WiFi network you configured to get online. Your computer or mobile device will disconnect from the Flame Boss access point and re-connect to a previously remembered WiFi network. If it does not, you may need to connect to your old WiFi network again.

WiFi Setup / Flame Boss Device

With your Flame Boss device set to Station Mode, press **MENU** until the following screen is displayed.

WiFi Name (SSID) Network Names

Press \triangledown or \blacktriangle to show available WiFi Names detected by the controller. Press **MENU** to select your WiFi name and proceed.

Entering Your Password:

- Press $\mathbf{\nabla}$ or \mathbf{A} to select a character.
- Press **MENU** to enter a character and move to the next position. This will duplicate the character.
- Repeat until all characters of your password are entered, then press **MENU**.
- Duplicate last character and select the → (Enter), then press **MENU**.
- Wait for the controller to connect and show your ID and Pin.

Character Order:

→ (Enter) a,A - z,Z 0 - 9 ~ - ? (Space) ← (Backspace)

If you make an error, select the ← (Backspace), then press MENU to remove the incorrect entry.

Note: If your WiFi network is using WEP security, you will enter the key in hex.

TCP/IP/MAC MENU

Use the TCP/IP/MAC Menu to change advanced network settings. Press **MENU** to go to the next screen, and press the \blacktriangle or \blacktriangledown buttons to change the setting.



OTHER MENU

Use the Other Menu to change the settings below. Press **MENU** to go to the next screen, and press the \blacktriangle or \triangledown buttons to change the setting.

Sound [Chirps & Alarm]	${\bf \nabla}$ or ${\bf \blacktriangle}$ changes the amount of sound from the controller.
LCD Contrast [35]	igvee or $igwed$ changes the LCD contrast.
Max Open Pause [2:00]	▼ or ▲ changes the maximum time the controller will stay in Open Pit mode (controller disables the blower to avoid over-stoking fire).
Temp Scale [Fahrenheit]	igvee or $igwed$ changes the amount of sound from the controller.
Version 2.01.001	Display shows the current version of the installed firmware. If you're hungry for more details about the firmware
